We have always been committed to create an environment in our school which helps the young mind to blossom and provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of child's personality, as academic session witnesses repositioning, restructuring and refocusing.

We set standards and goals for ourselves and strive to achieve them – be it in the area of sports, discipline, leadership and blending technology with academics and more.

(1) Academics:

"Success is the sum of small efforts, repeated day in and day out."

So we are proud to report that. 2023-24 batches of Class XII and X have brought many laurels to the school by their outstanding result. We attained 100% results in XII and X class board exams. Out of 66 students who attended class XII Board exam, our student K. Swathya scored 96% and became a topper in the county itself. K. Tejaswini secured 94 % and stood second. P. Gnanapradymna attained 93 % and placed 3rd.

When it comes to class CBSE board exams we achieved 100 % pass result. Our student B. Tagore Scored 95 % and became the school topper. T. Keerthi, G. Swetcha, Ch. Yagna Triveni and Ch. Sai Krishna scored 92% each and secured second position. Such rare feats always make our school owner's pride and neighbour's envy.

(2) IIT Foundation & Olympiads

"The quality of thinking determines the quality of your mind."

Participation in Maths, Science and English Olympiads itself is the biggest competition where a student competes to out shine others.

In the current year we conducted Three Olympiad tests such as International Maths Olympiad, International science Olympiad and International English Olympiad. Approximately 400 students from IIT foundation and other streams took the test very interestingly and are eagerly waiting for the result.

(3) Sport and Games

Champions are not made in the gyms. They are made from something they have deep inside them - a desire, a dream, a vision. Sports Competition inculcate the spirit of positive challenges and sportsmanship among the students and prepare them for the life ahead. Through sports and games we teach our students not only how to win but also how gracefully one has to accept failures. In our school we give adequate time for sports and games.

Vollyball, KhoKho, Tennikoit, Throw Ball, Shuttle Badminton, etc are some of the important games our children play in the outdoor. In door games like chess and caroms are also seriously promoted among our students.

This year also our under 17 and under 14 Kho team participated in the district level competition and stood in the 1st and 2nd position, respectively. 7 of our students were selected to state level competition.

(4) Co - Curricular Activities

Co curricular activities provide a platform for students to discover and nurture their passions and talents beyond the confines of the classroom. Hence we focused on conducting a variety of co-curricular activities like drawing, painting, essay writing, reading, inter house sports and games competitions and we honoured them with prizes.

A Special programme called 'OPEN FORUM' where the children get to learn the art of public speaking, body language depiction and the talent of self expression is being conducted on every Friday for our students from class 1st to 10th to equip them with oratory skills.

(5) National Cadet Corps (NCC):

The National cadet corps helps for nation building. It provides exposure to the cadets in a wide range of activities, with a distinct emphasis on social service, Discipline, and adventure training. The installation of NCC unit in NLF can be considered as a bench mark achievement for the school. There are 50 NCC student cadets taking active training under NCC wing. Every year they are supposed to participate in NCC camp outdoor. Girls and boys cadets are divided into two categories such as junior wing and junior division. And our NCC cadets are actively involving in social services like cleaning the reservoir, planting sapling and collecting plastic to keep our environment hazard free and nature friendly.

19th December 2024 witnessed a remarkable achievement in our NCC senior Division / Senior wing at the Junior college. The Commanding Officer Sri SK. Bhadra, NCC Unit Khammam paid a ceremonial visit at our NCC Unit and awarded our junior college students with NCC ' B' Certificate - a prestigious certificate that gives reservation to join in paramilitary Services like BSF, CRPF, CISF, SSB Indian Military Academy, National Defense Academy, etc. NCC Certificate holders have an edge over all other competitors as NCC training imparts ethics, moral Value, discipline and leadership skills which every Corporate and Multinational Companies would like to see in every job aspirants. It was indeed a feather in our cap undoubtedly.

(6) Self defence and Karate

Self defence was an over looked skill till yesterday, but it is of at most importance in today's society. In an age when life threat and molestation of children and women are rampant, it is important to ensure that our children and women can defend themselves if

the need arises. So our management has taken a strong decision for teaching our students martial arts like karate in our campus, bringing an instructor from Khammam.

In the recently concluded National Karate Championship held at Warangal 14 of our students participated and won Gold, Silver and bronze medals for their spectacular display. It was indeed a moment of joy when three of our students master K. Sriman Narayana, B. Revath and P. Bhanu prakash secured Gold, Silver & Brownze medals at the Open World Karate Championship held at Goa.

(7) Yoga

Yoga is an Indian spiritual and Physical practice whose origin dates back to prehistoric times. The importance of yoga in our life cannot be underestimated. It is a science that focuses on not only improving physical health but also mental and spiritual well being, which are the foundation of our life.

To inculcate all these benefits in our students, the management has provided us a yoga instructor to fine tune the skills of our students and relieve them from their mental stress caused by various situations. In the recently conducted state level yoga competition by Gangothri Organization at Karimnagar on 22nd December, 2024, 14 of our students participated and 7 of them were honored with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.

(8) Dance

Arts research has shown that students who study dance are more self - motivated, disciplined and focused. They are more expressive in their communication of emotions, thought and feeling. They are able to critically analyze their own work and the work of other, as well as being more creative and imaginative. So the school management has roped in a dance master to train and shine our students in all forms of dances.

(9) Art & Craft

Art and crafts as a subject in the school curriculum is typically taken for granted as a must for children and young kids in the formal education setup. By introducing arts and crafts to the kids and involving them in such activates in schools, you will invest in building their cognitive, physical, and social development. That is why our management has appointed an Art & craft Teacher as prescribed by the CBSE board to help children hone their skills.

(10) Teachers Training & Seminars

Excessive use of mobile phones has been linked to poor psychological health, including increased anxiety, feeling of loneliness, and low self esteem. It can also make student feel annoyed, frustrated and impatient when they can't use it. As the use of mobile phones is increasing among students community day by day, we have roped in Mr. Sudheer Sandra a renowned psychologist career counselor and behavioral skills coach to conduct a seminar on Art of Parenting for our parents and Mobile - free life for our student to promote mental health and well being on 20th December. This was such a successful programme where hundreds of parents attended it so earnestly and got motivated. It was a rarest of the rare program that no other schools in Wyrā division would ever think to execute.

The school believes in getting many organizations for in - house training purpose. Many of our teachers were sent for in - service training program conducted by Mac Millan Publishers India Private Limited - an international publishing company, Oxford University press, Edu -comp Solutions Ltd, E-Dac to improve teacher's efficiency, ability, knowledge and level of motivation in their professional work. On second Saturday in every month our teachers get training on various topics at New Era - our mother branch.

(11) Picnic and Excursion :

“All work and no play makes Jack a dull Boy”. The School has organized one day picnic programme for the students. This was a day when all the teachers and the students travelled, played, dined and entertained together with all the fun. This academic year we arranged two picnic trips, one to Wonderla Hyderabad and the other is Vanabhojanalu - An annual ritualistic picnic undertaken during karthikamasam.

(12) Festivals and Celebrations :

Celebrating events and festivals in our school has become an integral part of learning and building strong cultural belief. It will obviously bring all the people closer to the tradition, culture and heritage with happiness, peace and religious harmony. With this ideology we design celebration of festivals and events in the curriculum. Following are the events and festivals we celebrate in the school. Independence Day, Krishnashtami, Telugu Language Day, Vinayaka Chavithi, Teachers Day, Bathukamma, Diwali, Children's Day, Maths Day, Christmas, Fruits Day, and Colours Day etc., are a few to name here.

(13) Higher Education

A junior college is a post secondary educational institution offering quality education and training for developing a student's career. A high quality education at lower price is the motto of New Era Group, We launched +1 in the Academic year 2021 - 22 and imparting various courses like MPC+EAMCET & MAINS, BIPC+NEET.
